PRIMARY SCHOOL

ORDINANCE OF MINISTRY OF EDUCATION

on the core curriculum of kindergarten as well as core curriculum of general education for primary school, including students with moderate or notable intellectual disability, general education for industry-specific school of 1st degree, general education for special school and general education for post-secondary school.
