

Terms and Conditions of use of the facilities of Fpinka Climbing Centre

General Principles

1. People using the facilities of the climbing centre are obliged to familiarize with the Terms and Conditions and to sign the risk disclosure statement.
2. Outwear, shoes and other things can be left in the cloakroom.
3. Fpinka shall be not responsible for things left in the cloakroom and in the hall. In case of losing the locker key the amount of PLN 30 shall be charged.
4. Entrance to the hall only in changeable footwear.
5. Alcohol consumption and smoking cigarettes within the area of the centre is forbidden- people being under the influence of alcohol or other intoxicants shall be asked to leave the centre.
6. Climbing is performed on your own risk.
7. Beginners are obliged to contact the staff on duty in the centre.
8. Only the Staff on duty in the centre can perform the training of protection.
9. While belaying please remember the safety measures!- It is forbidden to belay in the distance or too to lower down the climbers.
10. For belay you have to use only the certified equipment and use it according to the recommendation of the producer.
11. The rope shall be fixed to the harness with use of figure-eight knot.
12. For climbing with bottom belay only dynamic ropes can be used.
13. It is forbidden to climb or lower on the ropes anchored only to one anchor.
14. It is forbidden to screw the position carabiners under load. If after running the route you want to pull off the rope, please leave the carabiner unscrewed.
15. It is forbidden to stay under the climbing person.
16. It is forbidden to make any changes in the equipment of the climbing wall. It is related among others to pulling off and rehanging expresses, ropes and untwisting the climbing holds.

17. Children and teenagers under 18 years old can climb only with the consent of their parents after previous signing a proper statement.

18. Parents are responsible for their children: a) Children under 16 year old can stay in the climbing halls only under the supervision of their parents, guardians or the staff of the centre. They cannot climb with bottom belay and they cannot belay others. b) Teenagers over 16 years old, with parental consent, can be trained like adult and then climb and belay on their own according to the Terms and Conditions.

Personal data processing and other consents

19. The user agrees for processing of his personal data and his proteges provided to the Climbing Centre, especially as defined in the act of personal data protection (unified text from May 2016, Dz.U. [Journal of Acts] 2015 pos. 2135, 2281, as amended from 01.04.2016, Dz.U. [Journal of Acts] 2016 r. pos. 195): - in the scope of data related to the use of facilities of the climbing centre, including payments for services and products by Fpinka sp. z o.o. with its registered office at ul. Macieja Miechowity 1 – as an administrator of personal data- in order to manage the centre, provide services and sell products, communicate marketing and sales information, send marketing and sales offers- for purposes related to the provision of service- especially declaration of the user about familiarization with the Terms and Conditions.

20. The user agrees for contact to telephone numbers and other channels of written and electronic communication for purposes of management of the climbing centre, provision of services and sales of products, communication of marketing and sales information, sending marketing and sales offers– relates to the User as well as their proteges.

21. The User agrees for providing data to entities related with the Climbing Centre and for using them in the scope, which the User agreed for towards the Climbing Centre. Such consent also relates to third parties providing services for the climbing centre.

22. The User of the Climbing Centre agrees for keeping copies of such documents created in relation to the climbing centre, especially at the use of the climbing centre.

23. In order to protect the property and ensure the safety in the facility, according to art. 5 and art. 6 pos. 1 pt. c and f of the ordinance of European Parliament and Council (EU) 2016/679 from April 27th 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal

data and on the free movement of such data as well as repeal of directive 95/46/WE (Dz.Urz.UE.L.2016.119.1), the facility is monitored (video monitoring).

24. Video monitoring covers climbing halls, the leisure part of the hall, gym, reception, passages and corridors.

25. Materials collected from the monitoring shall be used only for purpose defined in point 19.

26. Access to the materials collected from monitoring have only people who are authorised for processing data included in them.

27. Materials collected from monitoring shall be stored for the term of 90 days, after which they shall be destroyed in the way that would not make possible to restore them.

28. The acceptance of the Terms and Conditions tantamount with the consent for processing of data according to art. 5 and art. 6 pos. 1 pt. c and f of the ordinance of European Parliament and Council (EU) 2016/679 from April 27th 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data as well as repeal of directive 95/46/WE (Dz.Urz.UE.L.2016.119.1),

Final Provisions

29. In case of breaking the Terms and Conditions and objections of the Staff related to the safety, the person shall be asked to leave the centre.
